1. **Apologies:** as above

3. **Minutes** from previous Community Council Meeting of 25th April 2019 were proposed as an accurate record by Cllr B Crone and seconded by Cllr N Bennett.

4. **Highway Matters:**

a. **Waen passing places:** Clerk confirmed that despite chasing she has still not received any information from PCC. Cllr M Jones reported that the road is now also full of potholes. Clerk to chase and ask PCC to look into this. Chair Cllr M Smith reported that a tanker came off the road at the Argoed recently and the road is in a bad state.

5. **Matters Arising:**

- a. **Defibrillators & CPR Training:** Training in Trefeglwys to take place on Saturday 8th June. Two members of the public have booked onto the training so far. Clerk to publicise further.
The Clerk was told that she would receive the defibrillator for Llawryglyn at the end of last week but it has still not been received, she will continue to chase this up. Clerk has also been in contact with the Llawryglyn Village Association in regards to getting the defib installed and arranging training.
- b. **Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales:** Review of Electoral arrangements. Responses were received from Eluned Morgan AM and Russell George AM who are supporting the concerns of Trefeglwys Community Council.
- c. **Clinical Waste issue:** Following discussions at the previous meeting a letter was drafted and sent to the AM's along with County Cllr Phyl Davies in regards to clinical waste being sent to landfill as there are no services to collect from people as there used to be. Responses have been received from PCC and some AM's regarding this matter. Cllrs agreed for the Clerk to write to Powys Teaching Health Board regarding this matter and forward PCC's response to the letter sent by TCC.
- d. **Council email:** Clerk has not yet heard back from Upper Bridge Enterprises who host and manage the website about getting emails via the website. Clerk to chase up.
- e. **Street light in Llwynygog:** PCC responded to the Clerk to confirm that a team would look to repair this. Cllr J Anwyl confirmed that it is still not fixed as yet. Clerk to chase up.


9. **Chairman / Councillors Comments**
