Matters Arising

Web Site

The question arose again whether it was advisable to place resident information for village events on the Web Site. It was agreed to ask Mr Roger Malvern to contact us first if the situation arose.

Code of Conduct Training

Training is available in the Village Hall, Trefeglwys on Thursday 7th July 2016 6.30pm – 9.00pm. An e-mail has been forwarded to each Councillor. It was agreed to contact One Voice Wales to find out the cost for 8 Councillors to receive the training. There may be a bursary available with a reduction in cost.

Flower Box

Defibrillator – Mr Tim Ware has been contacted regarding a new battery for the Defibrillator. He has also been informed regarding the location of the device.

Day Centre

County Councillor Graham Jones asked the Council that if a volunteer committee were to take over the running of the Day Centre at Llanidloes would Trefeglwys Community Council consider helping with funding in the future if it is taken over. It was stated that the possibility of helping would be considered. County Councillor Graham Jones will be speaking to County Councillor Gareth Morgan regarding the matter of funding.
