**Planning -**

Electricity Act 1989: Overhead Lines (Exemption) (England and Wales) Regulations 2009  
Application Ref:DECC2016 0006 Grid Ref: 291890.16/291837.55 for Application made under Section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 to install LV overhead line for a second underground supply (removal of existing LV line) at Allt Goch Isaf, Llawr-Y-Glyn, Caersws.

It was agreed by six Councillors present that it would be to the benefit of the resident.

Application Ref: P/2016/0744 Grid Ref: 296240/291313.11 for Siting of a log cabin to provide accommodation for a rural Enterprise worker, creation of vehicular access, landscaping and all associated works at Cefn Barach, Trefeglwys, Caersws, Powys.

There were no objections to this planning application and it was agreed by six Councillors present that this project would help provide accommodation to a local business for a farm worker.

Application Ref: P/2016/0798 Grid Ref:289470.29/292474.92 for Installation of a 12.5 high lattice mast and all associated works at Esgair Goch, Staylitttle, Llanbrynmair, Powys.

There were no objections to this planning application. Six Community Councillors present agreed that it would be of benefit to the Community.

Application Ref P/2016/0837 Grid Ref: 292690.96/29166.57 for Listed building consent: Internal and external repairs and alterations at Cribyn, Llawr-Y-Glyn, Caersws, Powys.

There were no objections to this planning application. Six Community Councillors present agreed that it would help the preservation of one of the many listed houses in the area.
