Application Ref: P/2016/0761 Grid Ref: 296723.35/290294.53 for Demolition of existing store and construction of extension to Garage at Dolafon, 17 Maestrannon, Caersws, Powys.

Cllr Morris Smith and Cllr Rhiannon Jones declared an interest in this matter and vacated the room for this item. Cllr Beryl Crone took the chair.

The remaining four Councillors had no objections to this planning application. It was agreed that it would enhance the property and tidy up the existing wood shed.
